#### Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival 2023

It's a new year and things are going to start heating up for the Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival! The dates are June 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at the Overland Park Convention Center, Overland Park, Kansas.

January 1, 2023 is when all classes will be up for viewing on the website. You can also take a look at the Instructors for those classes and read their bios.

January 15, 2023 at 12:01AM is the date to start registering for the classes and purchasing tickets and merchandise. Registration will close June 9, 2023. There is no early registration for guilds.

There is a video on YouTube to help you learn how to use the KCRQF website to purchase your ticket(s), buy merchandise and sign up for classes. Here is the link to the KCRQF Ticket Purchasing video -

https://youtu.be/O8pQcNqoyCE. The Convention Center will be Cashless, meaning, anything outside of the vendors must be paid by credit/debit cards. Vendors will still take cash and credit cards.

Ticket prices are \$15/1 day, \$30/3 days or \$17 at the door. There will be a separate \$12 Saturday Only ticket available which must be purchased ahead of time. Tickets for children 4-12 years of age are \$10. Children 3 and under are free. Don't forget the tour with Sandy Gard to learn how she judges quilts. The ticket price is \$10.

Beginning March 1, 2023 will be the time to begin registering our guild's quilts that will be on display during the Festival. We have four booths to fill with our guild's beautiful quilts so PLEASE consider hanging your quilt at the Festival. The guidelines for a quilt is on the KCRQF website under the Home Tab – About Us – 2023 Guild Quilt Entries. The deadline for registration is March 31st.
