Our position is that although masks are not required, they are still encouraged.


## **Northland Quilt Show Special Exhibit**

Directions for registration can be picked up at the membership table. Members are limited to four entries and it is critical that the exact quilt measurements be listed on the registration. No field can be left empty on the registration form so use NA if necessary. The deadline for registration is July 31. There will be no judging of the quilt entries this year. Volunteer sign up for the show will begin next month using the Signup Genius App or at the monthly guild meetings.

Attendees: Patricia Rogers, Jerianne Kutny, Pam Peugh, Trudy Coogan, Roberta Whitefield, Teddie Broughton, Shirley Green, Ginger Cowley, Barbara Laxon, Karen Allen, Vicki Nagayama, Jo Ann Thompson and Barbara Moyer.

Bazaar: Trudy bought a sample package of fabric for bazaar. She is very happy with all the donations so far. Donations are accepted up to the 4th Thursday in August. Trudy mentioned JoAnn Borchelt will set up Sign Up Genius for volunteers to sign up to work the quilt show and will have lists made for use at meetings so people know what openings still exist.

Work times to come by to help process with donations are: 1:30-4pm every Tuesday. Please contact Karen Allen or Margaret Reichart to schedule. If you need another time please contact Trudy. Sign up Genius should be ready by July's Guild meeting.

Vendors: Gwen announced that all Vendor locations are sold out. YEA!!!! That means that the Special Exhibit will definitely be on the stage. In order to make it easier to enter and exit, we will look at blocking the stairs on the right side of the stage and use the ramp on the left side for entry to Special Exhibit A sign has been made to point visitors to the area.

Treasurer Report: Shirley Green informed us we have \$9000 in bank at this time. She has researched, purchased and set up a new debit/credit card reader system to be able to checkout purchases more efficiently. It was suggested that a \$10.00 minimum purchase for those need to use credit because of the fees we pay using the new reader.. We will be purchasing a larger stamp for these receipts. We will also have a couple of receipt books for those who pay with cash and need a receipt. A receipt, if required can be emailed or we can stamp the receipt from adding machine tape. A motion was made by Roberta Waterfield and seconded by Pam Peugh. Pass on a unanimous vote.

Door Prizes: We discussed the location for the Door Prizes and Opportunity Quilts in the Lobby. No decision was made.

Publicity: Pam Peugh is working on providing value to our sponsors for their participation and best placement of advertising before and during the show. She also needs list of vendors.

Selling older style racks: Smithville Guild has already purchased new racks. We will sell them on Face-book Marketplace or other venue after the show.

Silent Auction: Both Teddy and Marci have received a few donations. Teddy Broughton brought up that need our Guild members to step up and volunteer for next year's show. This is an issue in both guilds that the same people are relied upon to volunteer. Teddy suggested a joint meeting of the guilds to discuss the future of the guilt show if more people don't volunteer.

- Each member may enter up to 4 quilts and will need to completely fill out the online form.

- Registrations must be completely entered by July 31, 2021

Quilts will be available to be picked up on the Saturday of the show *after* 5 pm on Saturday at the church.

The link takes you to an electronic version of the previous paper form. You must complete all fields. Mark NA if the field is not applicable. Enter your name at the end of the document as your acceptance of the requirements and "your signature" of the form before submitting. Registration starts June 1, 2021 and ends July 31, 2021. 4 entries per person. If the link in the newsletter is not hyperlinked to the form, copy or re-type the link url from your newsletter into a web browser.

Before beginning the registration form please use a tape measure to accurately determine the length and width of your quilt. Accuracy is critical to determine quilt placement on the showroom floor.
