The Church has asked that we continue to wear our masks while in their facility.



- Registrations must be completely entered by July 31, 2021

Quilts will be available to be picked up on the Saturday of the show *after* 5 pm on Saturday at the church.

To access the registration online form, please use this <u>link</u> to register your quilts for our upcoming quilt show. https://tinyurl.com/NNQS2021 or, you can scan this QR Code.

The link takes you to an electronic version of the previous paper form. You must complete all fields. Mark NA if the field is not applicable. Enter your name at the end of the document as your acceptance of the requirements and "your signature" of the form before submitting. Registration starts June 1, 2021 and ends July 31, 2021. 4 entries per person. If the link in the newsletter is not hyperlinked to the form, copy or re-type the link url from your newsletter into a web browser.

Before beginning the registration form please use a tape measure to accurately determine the length and width of your quilt. Accuracy is critical to determine quilt placement on the showroom floor.
