Code of Conduct/Conflict of Interest - New 2027 - All Executive & Member Board persons will be required to read, agree and sign a Code Contract - To protect the integrity and reputation of KCRQF and the confidentiality of its information, the Executive and Members Boards are responsible for making decisions that serve the best interests of the organization and uphold the trust of its partners, sponsors, and participants.

Participating Guilds Website/Facebook - All participating guilds will be required to operate a public access Website or Facebook page and will be required to post KCRQF basic information here: KCRQF, event date/location, ticket information, web address. Sharing KCRQF posting is highly recommended within each cycle.

QUILT ENTRY: Showcase Challenge - For 2027, KCRQF turns up the heat with a celebration inspired by Kansas City's world-famous BBQ scene—where rich tradition meets fearless flavor. This theme invites quilters to lean into the bold: big blocks, daring design choices, creative seasoning, and unexpected combinations. Just like KC pitmasters, quilters bring heritage, innovation, and personality to every creation. This year's challenge celebrates that same craft: slow-built skill, signature style, and a little extra spice. Spotlight Quilter - Do we want to continue this for 2027? The introduction of the 2025 Spotlight Quilter program honors the unwavering dedication of our regional guilds, whose volunteer efforts make the festival possible This special feature will highlight one remarkable quilter from each guild, showcasing their talents and honoring the integral role they play in KCRQF's continued success.

2027 Commemorative Logo/T-Shirt Design - Everyday Stitches - Trish Price and Jennifer Dick have been selected to create the 2027 T-shirts. Attendee T-shirts will be on Black - goal to increase sales.

Special Exhibits - Honoring Women in Military

- 100 Honor Quilts (like Quilt of Valor) to be constructed by 17 guilds - each guild crafting approx. 6 quilts. Size 60" x 80"
- Fabrics - bring donation of fabrics to April meeting - also will solicit donations from PBStudio, and other fabric manufacturers. Batting & Backing
- Call out for volunteers for quilting & Binding
- Recipients - Lynda Loomis - gathering information on women vets - guilds are welcome to offer names of recipients, contact local vet organizations
- Display to be at front entrance (where demo stage was in 2025) - Award ceremony to be Saturday 2pm
- Special Saturday - Veteran ticket discount - TBD - (quilt recipients - FREE ticket)

Community Quilt Drop Off available - KCRQF will allow drop off of quilts such as Linus Project, Sleep in Heavenly Peace, etc organizations to host a drop off box at the festival. Need to find person to be responsible for delivery

Dress Up Day themes - Festival attendees to wear garments/bag they crafted within the theme
