### Minutes of General Meeting March 11, 2021



President Barbara Laxson called the meeting to order and thanked everyone for coming. Donna Brattin made a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting—JoAnne Borchelt seconded and it was approved.

Barbara called on the committee chairs for their report;

Activities Committee-Rhonda Thiedke reported that there will be a Highway 36 Quilt Shop Hop this year in April if anyone is interested in going.

Quilt Show—Trudy Coogan that plans are to go ahead with our Quilt Show in September, The set up will be September 15-16 and the show will be the 17,18 & 19. Some changes have been made—there will be no Judges and only 3 ribbons will be given. We are still in need of a Vendors Chair. By the Yard will not be a vendor this year but Little Red Hen will be. There will be no program book this year but a list instead. There will be no Tea Room. We will have the Silent Auction with funds raised going to the Veteran's Community Project—Tiny Houses. There will be no food served for set up. We will have the Bazaar with fabric, patterns, misc supplies, thread, rulers, stencils. We need a place big enough to store and prepare the items donated.

Mini Groups—Helen Tidics reported that the Wool group had not met the last 4 months but would be resuming meeting this month and they have room for 1 or 2 more members. None of the other mini groups are currently meeting.

The Opportunity quilt is finished and just needs the binding sewn on which is in the closet at the church.

KCRQF—JoAnne Borchelt reported that plans are moving forward using precautions for safety. Classes are now available and you can go to the website and register. We do still have a few spots available for quilts—to bigger than 93"x93" or smaller that 24"x24". There will be no 3 day passes sold at the door but you can get them through JoAnne. Dates for the show are June 17,18,19. Our guilds responsibility this year is for Door Prizes and our booth. You can go to Sign Up Genius to sign up for 2 hour time slots. The 3 day passes will be \$30 and one day will be \$10 or \$12. There will be limited food available.

Retreat—Jane Bromberg reported that the date for our next retreat is February 2022.

Scrap quilt—Daphne and Denise reported that it is coming along and they are now working on the borders.

Show and Tell—For the present we will do pictures so if you have made a quilt in 2020 you can send a picture to JoAnne. At our May meeting in person those whose last name A to N can show one quilt and O to Z can show one quilt at the June meeting.

Our website has been updated to show the Zoom meetings and Quilt Show updates. Sunshine & Shadows—Paula Releford had knee replacement. Helen Sellers is not doing well as her lymphoma is back.

New Business—Global Quilt Connection will have a Sampler online class May 22-23. It will be 2 to 5 pm both days and each session will be 15 minutes. Guild will pay the fee and there will be an online poll to see how many are interested. If you know of someone that is not tech savvy but would like to attend you can do a Buddy system and invite them to your home.

We took a poll on how many members want to start meeting at the Oak Grove Park and when and it was 100% to start meeting in May at the Park and 70% voted to meet in the afternoon as the weather may still be cool in the mornings. The May meeting will be at the Park starting at noon. There will be no snacks provided but may bring a snack. There will be Picnic tables but may want to bring your own chair if concerned about social distancing.

It was announced that they are needing quilts at the Hospice House at NKC Hospital.

The meeting was adjourned and Jane Bromberg gave a very informative program on Tricks and Tips for Organization in our sewing rooms.



Our job at the show this year is door prizes. We will collect door prizes from the vendors and we will be responsible for giving them out. This coming week I will be sending out a new way for may of you to sign up to volunteer. It is called Sign Up Genius. If you are new to this, it is simple. Here are some instructions. Give it a try we may be using this in the future for other things.

When you receive an invite to a sign up, you can sign up with or without creating an account.
 If you receive an emailed invitation to sign up, click the View Sign Up button in the email to access



the sign up.

• For a standard sign up, click the **Sign Up** button next to the slot(s) you want to sign up for. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the **Submit & Sign Up** button. If you do not have a computer or unable to use Sign Up Genius please contact me, JoAnn Borchelt and I will sign you up to work at the quilt show.

If you would like to have a quilt judged you will need to go to the KCRQF.com website and fill out your registration and pay your fee. You can sign up for classed via the website starting Jan. 15. Merchandise and show tickets are also being sold on the website and paid through the guild. Check it out!

I still need a few quilts for our guild to display. They can't be larger than 96" x 96" or smaller than 24" x 24". Must be finished between Jan. 2019 and now.
