



The meeting was called to order by Co-Chair Jean Newton.

Bonnie Smith is working on the insurance rider – agent on vacation but says we will be covered. Bonnie will go to his office as soon as he returns from vacation and get this resolved as quickly as possible. Hoffman needs ASAP and it must be in the name of the legal entity – “Quilter’s Guild of the Northland Nitetime Needlers”.

**Hoffman Challenge** – We will be getting Crystalia Quilt Trunk B set of 40 quilts.

**Food** - Asst. Co-Chair Joy Behrens is checking with a St. Joe High School to see if they would provide food. The Salvation Army chef said they would be our safety net. She will discuss and get an answer very soon as we need to know before the program is printed.

**Silent Auction** – Helen Tidics and Carol Sparks reported that we have 32 and 15 collected so far. They have or will send pictures to Leah for Facebook.

**Sponsors** – Have received \$775 so far, 2 open issues – Prairie Point says they sent form, paid and that the check has cleared but no one has seen it – Pam Peugh is working to resolve and is also waiting for Missouri Sewing Machine ad. Sonic has paid.

**Ribbons** – Janice reported they are being worked.

**Quilt Registration** – Vicki reported issues with the software. She gave a sample of the card we attach to each quilt to all and asked for input from the committee as to possible revisions. She has entered everything in a spreadsheet and is making it work. JoAnn Borchelt will proof the entries and pass the forms to Roberta for the binder to be used in September. A sheet will be printed to be given when quilts are received. Members will bring that sheet for quilt release. Also, Jean will work on putting the number assigned to each quilt on a card that will be attached to each quilt for judging.

There were 94 quilt registration forms turned in at the July guild meetings. Last year we had 124. After discussion, it was determined that we would send a request to both guilds for more quilts to be entered. Members can provide Vicki with their name, the name of the quilt and the length and width by Friday, August 4 and turn in completed registration forms at the August guild meeting. Guild member Dixie Sherlock passed away in an accident while on vacation. Carol will talk with her cousins to see if they would be comfortable with entering any of her quilts as a memorial.

**Vendors/Vendor Quilt** – Pam Palmer reported that all spaces are filled. All checks are in or in the mail. Receipts are \$2,045 with \$55 more on the way. We discussed rates for 2018 and a motion was made and passed to raise the rates \$15 per space.

**Quilt Release** – No new info.

**Boutique** – Everything has been priced except books, patterns, etc. They are doing more with less as there are fewer volunteers. Mary Ann Robker is handling fabric. Volunteers are still working Wednesday from 9 – 12. Mary Hunter needs the finished items back to her by September 1 so she can price them. There are lots of new things that people could give as gifts. The boutique cash box is missing.

We need a way to dispose of the items that don't sell and that we don't want to retain – suggestions are welcome. They want all the display units and tables they can get. About 16 tables used last year.

**Program Booklet** – Joy is working on a theme for 2018. All the info needs to be to Gwen by August 5.

**Show Hostesses** – No new info.

**Admissions** – Trudy Coogan and Cherie Pedego will work to get members signed up to fill the needs.

**Publicity** – E-mail Leah Stanley [LLLNP60@gmail.com](mailto:LLLNP60@gmail.com) if you have pictures of quilts, etc. that can be put on Facebook.


