# SWEET TREAT RETREAT 2017

Sweet Retreat 2017


Sweet Retreat is just around the corner. I hope you all are looking forward to it as much as we are. I will have a strip of fabric for you for your background of the blocks that someone will win to make a sweet quilt. If you have a "bloc loc" for trimming your HST use that to trim the squares down - I love mine and I find it helps me get my HST (half square triangles) perfectly trimmed each time. Prairie Point Quilt Shop sells them. Make sure you ask for a lesson at PPQ shop!

Here is what you will need to make the Sweet Treat Jar Block:

A-One 4 1/2 inch square of candy fabric  
B-Four 1 1/4" squares of background for snowball  
C-One 3" x 1 1/2" dark for jar cover  
D-Two 2 3/8" x 1 1/2" background  
E-One 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" background  
F-two 4 1/2 x 1 1/2" background

This block is put together by using quarter inch seam allowance.

Think of this as making rows (horizontally) then once all your "rows" are made then you can sew them to each other. Lay each piece out beside your sewing machine so you can see it- and then as you piece each row- put the rows together to make sure you have them placed correctly.



Candy Taffy or Hour Glass Block:

A- 2 half square triangles (HST)- sewn together as the "wrapper" of the candy- use fabric for background and fabric which will "play" as the wrapper. 1 each 3" x 3" place them right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on lighter fabric. sew a 1/4 inch from the line on each side. Cut down the drawn line and press to the darker fabric. You will have 2 HST but first trim them down to 2 1/2 inches square.  
B- 7- 2 1/2 inch square pieces-  
1- will be the "candy" fabric for the middle piece  
4- will be around the candy and matching the outside triangle from the HST  
2 - will be a different color for the outside squares.

# SWEET TREAT RETREAT 2017

## Friendship Star-

This one is optional- thought it might be nice for sharing with your friends... you will use only 2 fabrics -this is your block so you can be creative if you like but for the sake of ease of instruction I will be explaining for 2 fabrics.

You will have 3 horizontal rows to sew together

Using 2 squares each to make HST (half square triangles) place right sides together, with a diagonal line drawn on the lighter fabric sew 1/4 inch away down each side of the line. cut on line and press to the darker fabric. With two sets you should have 4 HST.

HST- cut 2 each fabric at 3" x 3" follow instructions to make HST (4) from these pieces. Trim to 2 1/2 inch square.

5- 2 1/2 inch square (4 background fabric--1 primary fabric)

(one will be the middle of the star so fabric must match one of the fabrics from your HST)

place wings of star to match on diagram and place background and in four corners. Sew rows together. Press middle row towards middle and top and bottom rows to background fabric squares for ease of nesting.


