The KCRQF is still scheduled for next June 2021, for now. Our job for the show will be **Door Prizes** which is considered Minimum Involvement. Below is the option for distribution that was selected.

OPTION ONE: 50/50 split:

The second 50% will be based on committee weights. Maximum involvement would be weighted at 1.5 Moderate involvement would be weighted at 1.25

Minimum involvement would be weighted at 1.

Showcase Challenge for the KCRQF


We are excited to announce the 2021 Showcase Challenge and are requesting that you provide your guild members the following information as soon as possible through an email blast or your next newsletter:
